BIG HAPPENINGS AROUND WEST KESSLER

I spoke with Matt Holley, the developer of Kessler Woods and this new phase. He told me that Phase III has one kink to iron out. The property at N. Oak Cliff and Davis (the ugly, old church) is zoned for single-family homes, and current zoning will not support their plan for that property. I think he wants to pursue having the property rezoned. One concern that I raised was that of three-story dwellings. However, he assured me—and plan below supports this—that anything built on that property will only be two story. That's good news. Also good news, is that the plan calls for revitalizing Davis and incorporating greenspace into the development using the existing old creek bed as the starter. The rezoning thing will be one of those big, Dallas-red-tape issues. Rezoning requests always involves neighbor-input process, impact studies, etc. So far though—coming from the guy who will have them right next door, it sounds like the improvements will be a boon for us all, and at this early stage, I'm going to support the rezoning. However, I reserve the right to change my mind. I have a contact down at city hall who should be able to keep me (and you) in the loop on this issue. — Lance Schlegel

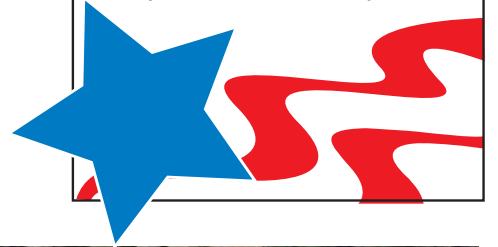
