Do you need a Blue Bin Recycling cart? Just visit [www.dallascityhall.com](http://www.dallascityhall.com) or call 3-1-1. Recycling cuts down on the amount of trash going to the landfill, which helps the environment. If you recycle you can probably only put the trash out once a week too.

### Brush and Bulky Collection

Many people missed the December pick up of bulk trash because we were used to the pick up on Thursdays. Our bulk trash is picked up promptly at 7:00 on Monday of our trash week. The route starts on Tenna Loma. It is a violation to place your bulk trash out before or after your collection week. Violations will result in a \$250 citation. Warning tickets are not issued for bulk trash violations, so be sure you know our bulk collection week. The newsletter calendar shows you which week is the 3rd Monday of each month.

### City Laws:

#### Parking violations

(Ord. 14584) A person commits an offense if he leaves standing or parked in a public street, alley, or other public place, an unattended vehicle or other private property for a continuous period of time longer than 24 hours.

#### Dogs

SEC. 7-4.8. Defecation of Dogs on public and private property; Failure to carry materials and implements for the removal and disposal of dog excreta. An owner of a dog commits an offense if he knowingly permits, or by insufficient control, allows the dog to defecate in the city on private property or on property located in a public place. West Kessler - be kind to your neighbors, please be a responsible dog owner.
