- Board will vote on budget at February 15, 2017 meeting

#### Mardi Gras Parade Committee

- 9th Annual Go Oak Cliff Mardi Gras Parade is scheduled for Sunday, February 26, 2017 at 4:00PM
- Line-up is at 2:00 pm ٠
- Float design and theme was presented to the board
- Cost of float is \$2,450 Requested WKNA pay \$600 towards the balance and private donations will be used to cover the additional cost
- The float can have approx. 15 people ride and unlimited number walk near the float
  - To ride on the float, neighbors will need to purchase min. 1 case (7 gross) of beads and wear a costume provided by 0 the Mardi Gras Committee
  - Joseph can preorder beads in bulk 0
- Angle and Stephanie are creating/sewing the costumes
- Brunch will be at Joseph and Angie's home on Sunday, February 26, 2017 at 11:00AM
- Kent and Joseph will work on the first communication related to the float participation, parade details, and related events

#### Action Items

- First communication will be sent out by Shawn during the week of January 30, 2017
- Social media and website will be update with Mardi Gras icons and advertisements by February 3, 2017
  - Motion to Appropriate Funds \$100 for 2018 entry fee and \$600 for float (Passed): David Cooper moved to approve, Jonathan Saxer seconded

#### 501c3 Status

- We are no longer under the umbrella of Old Oak Cliff Conservation League
- Paperwork to apply for 501c3 tax exemption is almost completed
- One-time fee will range from \$260 \$400 depending on receivables at the time of the application
- Joseph and Jonathan have agreed to work together to ensure the application and supporting documents are submitted for review and the application is filed before the next scheduled meeting (State filing of Articles of Incorporation and IRS Taxexempt application)
- Joseph proposed the idea of creating a community ambassador or charity chair to establish and maintain our chartable efforts as part of our 501c3 charitable status

#### Action Items

- Joseph will research the West Kessler Employer Identification Number, if one cannot be found he will apply for a new EIN
- Joseph and Jonathan to have application and supporting documents completed and sent for review by February 10, 2017 Joseph will submit application before February 15, 2017
  - Motion to Proceed with 501c3 Application (Passed): Teresa Harvey moved to approve, Stuart Gill seconded

#### Post Office Box

- Joseph presented the idea of having a PO Box for the association
- Would allow continuity to receive dues and mail for the association
- Would help with privacy on documents required for the IRS as board member's details are listed for public review
- All Executive Board Members would have a key to access the PO Box
- Cost is \$85 a year

#### Action Items

- Joseph will secure a post office box for the association .
- Joseph will present keys to the Executive Board of Directors
- PO Box address will be published on the website
  - Motion to Approve (Passed): David Cooper moved to approve, Teresa Harvey seconded

#### Job Details for the Executive Committee

- Teresa suggest establishing standard operating procedures and job descriptions for the board
- Jonathan would like to define the score of the Treasurers role with the possibility of adding a person to review tax filings

#### **Tree Planting Initiative**

- Joseph discussed native tree seeds that have been collected in the neighborhood
- Seeds were sent to the University of North Texas and new trees were grown
- Trees will be used to plant along the Trinity River banks
- The association should receive 20 40 trees to plant around our neighborhood
- Joseph would like to reach out to our neighbors on North Boulevard Terrace and work with the community to plant and care for a few of the native tree samples
- Trees need to be planted by the end of February 2017
- The Beautification Committee will help organize this new initiative

#### Park Reclamation Project – Hampton/Plymouth

- Joseph presented the idea of reclaiming an unused city-owned parcel of located at SW corner of Hampton and Plymouth
- The land was donated to Stevens Park Golf Course but has not been used for many years
- Teresa indicated this area used to be a small park with benches, picnic tables, gravel paths, and native plants
- Joseph is currently having conversations with Councilman Scott Griggs, North Texas Naturalist, and the City of Dallas Environmental employees regarding project viability.
- Scott Griggs said that we could request consideration to get help with sewage work through the 2017 bond package
- Joseph requested the establishment of an exploratory committee to begin reviewing and researching the project
- May require establishing a secondary 501c3 for this project

#### Action Items

- Motion to Approve Exploratory Committee (Passed): Jonathan Saxer moved to approve, Stuart Gill seconded
- Established exploratory committee to include Stuart Gill (representing the Beautification Committee), Kent Frederick, Teresa Harvey, and Joseph Beckham

#### 2017 Bond Package Review/Recommendations

- Joseph requested we review the current bond package and provide feedback to Councilman Scott Griggs
- Also, soliciting suggestions for line items from West Kessler and surrounding area that should be added to the bond package
- Mariam Andersen may be willing to help WKNA present a position statement to Griggs
- Bond Package was initially announced for May vote, but may occur in November

#### Action Items

- Joseph will check with Mariam to see if she wants to spearhead this activity
- Joseph will check with Griggs regarding deadline for feedback data
